WORKER/ENTERTAINER TICKETS

Workers and entertainers are admitted to the festival at no cost. Families and friends of workers and entertainers are not. To avoid paying the entry fee worker/entertainer tickets must be presented at the ticket gate EACH DAY. Worker/Entertainer tickets are the same for adults and youth.

Each organization should request enough tickets to cover all workers and/or entertainers for your organization. However, it should be noted that the number of workers each organization will be asked to supply for other festival duties will be determined by the number of worker/entertainer tickets ordered.
